NOTICE OF RACE **2019 Hawaii J-80 State Championship Regatta** **Sunday, October 6, 2019**

1. RULES: This regatta will be governed by the current year Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with US Sailing prescriptions, excluding the prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2 and 63.4, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions. Each boat must have a unique sail number on both sides of the mainsail. The organizing authority is Kaneohe Yacht Club.

2. CLASSES: The regatta is open to the J80 class provided that three or more boats come to the starting area that day.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY:

3.1 The regatta is open to J80 owned or chartered by clubs or members of clubs affiliated with the Hawaii Yacht Racing Association (HYRA). The skipper shall be a dues-paying or life member in good standing of a HYRA affiliated club (or the spouse or minor child of such a member) and must be the helmsman at all times while racing except in an emergency.

3.2 Eligible owners or skippers may enter by submitting the attached race entry form with the entry fee to KYC no later than 0930 October 6, 2019.

4. FEES: The entry fee will be \$25.00. Make checks payable to Kaneohe Yacht Club.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

The warning signal for subsequent races will follow the finish of the prior race within 10 minutes. There will be a maximum of five races in the regatta.

6. MEASUREMENT: All boats must have been approved by the respective fleet measurers.

- 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sailing Instructions for this event will be posted on the KYC and HYRA websites and will be available at the Skippers' Meeting.
- 8. VENUE and COURSES:** The venue will be Kaneohe Bay between Moku O'Loe (Coconut Island) and KYC. The courses will be displayed by the Race Committee at or prior to the warning for each race as described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9. SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, will apply. A minimum of three races must be completed to constitute a series. If more than three races are completed, one race will be discarded from each boat's series score. This modifies Rule A2.
- 10. PRIZES:** Winners will be announced at the end of the regatta. Perpetual Trophies will be presented at the annual Kaneohe Yacht Club awards ceremony.
